Subject: Weekly COVID-19 Update

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues, Baptist Homes Society remains committed to the fulfillment of our mission. Since our last weekly COVID-19 update on March 19, one dining services staff member in independent living on the Providence Point campus has tested positive for COVID-19. There were no new positive cases of COVID-19 in skilled nursing, personal care or memory support on the Providence Point campus. There were no positive cases of COVID-19 on the Baptist Homes campus since the last update.

Per recent CMS guidelines, staff continue to be tested routinely. Residents and staff will be tested if symptomatic or in the event of a positive case. As has been previously mentioned, in the event of a positive case in either a resident or staff member, visitation will be suspended until outbreak testing is completed.

At Providence Point, visitation is occurring in personal care on the 1st and 2nd floor and by appointment in skilled nursing. Visitation remains temporarily closed for the 3rd floor of personal care and in memory support. At Baptist Homes, visitation is occurring in personal care on the 1st and 2nd floor and remains temporarily closed for the 3rd floor of personal care and skilled nursing. Screening, masking, and social distancing guidelines have not changed.

The federal (CMS) regulations for visitation were updated on Wednesday, March 10, for healthcare entities. Visitation specifics for skilled nursing and personal care on each campus can be found on the websites under the Resources tab and the 'Visiting our Community' link.

The skilled nursing, personal care, and memory support residences continue to follow federal and state mandates. Staff and visitors continue to be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 at the time of entering our buildings and must wear a mask at all times while on our campuses, inside or outside of our buildings. Direct care staff must continue to wear N-95 masks.

In order to help to contain the spread of COVID-19 and to keep ourselves, our families, and the residents we serve free from the COVID-19 virus, each of us must be diligent to continue to:

- Wear masks both while at work, as well as outside your home in the community.
- Wear masks appropriately, ensuring mask covers both nose AND mouth,
- Practice social distancing of 6 feet or more and avoid gatherings of more than 10 people,
- Continue to observe appropriate cough and sneeze etiquette,
- Continue to wash hands frequently for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, and
- Use hand sanitizer frequently when hand washing is not practicable.

Thank you for your continued understanding, cooperation, and compliance with all of the measures that are in place due to COVID-19.
